**Subpoenas to the WA Health Services**



1. The subpoena dated 11 October 2021 issued to the following entities pursuant to order 2 of the 6 October 2021 orders be adjourned for production by 6 December 2021:
  - (a) South Metropolitan Health Service (ABN 92 264 056 442);
  - (b) North Metropolitan Health Service (ABN 61 282 636 952);
  - (c) East Metropolitan Health Service (ABN 11 297 417 435); and
  - (d) WA Country Health Service (ABN 26 680 145 816).
2. Pursuant to section 37P(2) of the *Federal Court of Australia Act 1976* (Cth), the parties are to confer by 14 December 2021 for the purpose of settling the content and form of notices concerning opt out and registration proposed to be issued to group members identified by the entities in order 1 above, in each of the Related Proceedings, which is thereafter to be provided to the Associate to Justice Lee by one email, including the draft notice for each proceeding.
3. The Related Proceedings be listed for a further case management hearing at 9.30am on 17 December 2021.

#### **Targeted Advertising of Abridged Notice and Publication of Notices**

4. Pursuant to s 33X, 33Y and 33ZF of the *Federal Court Act of Australia Act 1976* (Cth) (FCA), the Multi-Proceeding Abridged Notices set out in Annexure "A" are approved for distribution in accordance with order 5.
