### **ORDER**

#### **THE COURT ORDERS THAT:**

##### **Precision confidential financial data**

1. By 12 noon Monday 16 October 2017, Precision to produce to Korda Mentha, by the provision of file site access to the email address [andrew.ross@kordamentha.com](mailto:andrew.ross@kordamentha.com), such financial data of Precision in MYOB or Xero, including any archived file, for each of the years 2011 to date including, in relation to Xero, a user read-only account with access to Precision's Xero account for each of the relevant years, such data to include, where available, chart of accounts, export of Precision's invoices and bills, export of Precision's fixed assets (if any), export of the general ledger data, trial balance, detailed general ledger report, detailed account transactions report, aged receivables summary, aged payable summary, balance sheet, profit and loss statements and business activity statements.
2. Within seven days of the date of this order, Precision to provide an explanation for the apparent discrepancy between the figures for Precision's profit appearing in the profit and loss statement for the year ending June 2012 (dated 28 February 2012) and the figure stated in the document called "Annual Report" relating to the year ending June 2013.
3. Until further order, pursuant to section 37AI of the *Federal Court of Australia Act 1976* (Cth), publication or other disclosure of the documents provided pursuant to orders 1 and 2 above (including any electronic data) be prohibited, except as stipulated in order 4 below.



4. Publication and disclosure of the documents referred to in order 3 may be made:
  - (a) by Precision; and
  - (b) to external legal representatives, counsel and experts retained by the parties in these proceedings who have signed a confidentiality undertaking.
5. The Court notes that the ground for the orders in 3 and 4 above is that they are necessary to prevent prejudice to the proper administration of justice.
