BY CONSENT THE COURT ORDERS THAT:

- 1 Order 5 of 1 December 2017 is vacated in respect of the applicant/First Cross respondent (Domino's) and the respondents.
- 2 Orders 6 to 10 of 1 December 2017 are vacated.
- 3 **By Tuesday 10 April 2018:**
 - (a) Domino's give discovery of documents in the categories listed at Annexure A to these Orders; and
 - (b) the respondents give discovery of documents in the categories listed at Annexure B to these Orders.
- 4 Order 2 does not affect each party's ongoing obligations in relation to earlier orders for discovery.
- 5 List the matter for a case management conference and the hearing of any disputed matters in relation to discovery arising from the pleading amendments on **17 April 2018**, the parties to file and serve outline submissions limited to 3 pages in relation to any matters not agreed, by **5pm on 12 April 2018**.
- 6 By **Friday 11 May 2018**, Domino's and Navman file and serve any lay affidavit evidence arising solely from the pleading amendments.
- 7 By **Friday 15 June 2018**, the respondents file and serve any lay affidavit evidence in answer arising solely from the pleading amendments.



- 8 By **Monday 16 July 2018**, Domino's and Navman file and serve any lay affidavit evidence in reply and expert evidence in chief arising solely from the pleading amendments.
- 9 By **Friday 17 August 2018**, the respondents file and serve any expert affidavit evidence in answer arising solely from the pleading amendments.

Categories for further discovery by Domino's and Navman Wireless

In this schedule:

Document has the meaning given in Schedule 1 of the Federal Court Rules 2011.

Domino's Amended Claim refers to Domino's Third Amended Statement of Claim dated 13 December 2017.

Precision Defence refers to Precision Tracking's Defence dated 14 December 2017 to Domino's Amended Claim.

Otherwise, terms used have the meanings of terms defined in the pleadings.

A. DOMINO'S
