THE COURT DECLARES THAT:

- The Second Respondent contravened s 500 of the Fair Work Act 2009 (Cth) (the FW Act) on 3 December 2014 at a construction site at Geelong Grammar School in Corio (the Site) by:
 - a) intentionally hindering and obstructing Harris HMC, its subcontractors and their workers by calling and conducting a meeting on the Site, causing the subcontractors and their employees to leave the Site and causing work to cease;
 and
 - b) acting in an improper manner by failing to provide notice of his entry in contravention of s 487 of the FW Act, failing to produce his entry permit on request in contravention of s 489 of the FW Act, refusing to leave the Site when requested, making threats about not re-opening the Site and acting rudely and aggressively on the Site.
