#### **THE COURT ORDERS THAT:**

1. Paragraph 1 of the Application filed 16 May 2017 be amended pursuant to rule 8.21(1)(a) of the *Federal Court Rules 2011* to read “The appeal against the decision of the First Respondent made on 1 May 2017 (“**decision**”) be allowed and the decision be set aside”.
2. Pending further order, there be a stay on the repayment of \$277,183.70 under regulation 8.120 of the *Bankruptcy Regulations 1996* by the applicants to the bankrupt estate.
3. By 23 June 2017, the First Respondent make available for inspection by the Applicants, the documents he relied upon in making the decision (“**disclosure documents**”).
4. By 30 June 2017, the Applicants inspect the disclosure documents.
5. By 24 July 2017, the Applicants file and serve Grounds of Appeal.



6. By 7 August 2017, the Applicants file and serve any application for the hearing of a preliminary question as to the nature of their appeal.
7. By 14 August 2017, the Applicants file and serve an outline of submissions in relation to the preliminary question.
8. By 21 August 2017, the First Respondent file and serve an outline of submissions in relation to the preliminary question.
9. The preliminary question be listed for hearing on 30 August 2017 at 10:15 am.
10. Costs reserved.
11. Liberty to apply.
