 - b. any evidence in response to the respondents.
5. By 4pm on 22 April 2022, each applicant and each respondent file and serve any outline of submissions in relation to both Carriage Motion(s), such outline not to exceed ten (10) pages.
6. The matter be listed for case management and the Carriage Motion(s) to be listed for hearing at 10.15am on 13 May 2022, with an estimate of one day.
7. The first respondent and second respondent be permitted to appear by way of video link.

Defence

8. The respondents not be required to file a defence until further order.
